

Since 2009, Joey Feinstein (aka *FineRhyme*) has educated over 120,000 K-College students about our shared environmental challenges and what we can do to address them.

Building off STEAM content around energy, climate, and waste, his multi-media assemblies emphasize action on these issues and leverage the legacy of social movements to inspire students in believing they can make a positive difference in their world.

Student engagement is further amplified through "Raptivism": a unique approach to learning that uses original rap music to inspire environmental activism and education through hip-hop.

Joey's work spans assemblies and classroom enrichment, including workshops and residencies.

All offerings can be customized to fit a school's unique curriculum and culture, along with

NGSS and CCSS guidelines.

Assemblies

Each assembly includes standard customization with themes and topics that can be tailored to school specific interests. Additional customization is available upon request.

Assemblies are offered as stand-alone presentations or a *Sustainability Series* in which content presented on different days builds off of previous programs. This video explains more.

Joey's workshops include student "Raptivism" Residencies, "Future Labs", math intensives, spoken word workshops, the "Plastic Challenge" and more.

From single class enrichment and all school assemblies to multi-week "residencies," each can be designed to compliment a school's specific interests and curriculum. Below are examples of previous custom programming.








PERSONAL EMPOWERMENT
